## CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Dear Members,

**The Annual General Meeting will be held on Sunday 20th of September at 9.00am** and we will need nominations for the following six positions:

- Chairperson
- Business Manager (also acts as Deputy Chairperson)
- Treasurer
- Secretary
- House Director
- Bowls Director

Jeff McLennan, the current House Director, is retiring this year and Reg Walls and myself have indicated we are going to retire next year so we need members to step up and get involved this year so we have members we can pass the baton on to in September 2021. It's called succession planning.

As a transition initiative, the Board is considering inviting members to become "assistants to Board members" next year and these members will be involved and will be invited to attend Board meetings as observers to "learn the ropes". So, when we call for nominations at the AGM, please consider nominating for one of these positions and you will have a year to become intimately familiar with the way the Board operates. As JFK said many years ago (modified for our club) – "Ask not what your Club can do for you, but what you can do for YOUR Club".

It was really disappointing this year that out of 250 registered bowling members we could not get one member to take on the position

of Bowls Director. What effectively happened is that it increased the work load of others on the Board with most of the work done by the House Director – he had enough to do. The following is the revised Position Description for the Bowls Director as prepared by Reg Walls:

*The Bowls Directors functions include, but are not limited to:*

- *Control and co-ordination of barefoot bowls in liaison with the Club Manager including maintenance of a roster of volunteers;*
- *Control and Co-ordination of Corporate Bowls including maintenance of a roster of volunteers;*
- *Maintain stocks of score cards in consultation with the Games Directors. Order as required;*
- *Maintain sufficient stocks of bowls stickers – order when necessary. Liaise with the Business Manager for sponsorship of stickers.*

This is not an onerous task and we have many members who are prepared to assist as a volunteer so it doesn't mean the Bowls Director has to be present for every barefoot bowls booking.

If you have good organisational and people skills then please consider taking on this position and participate in the running of your club. It can be a very rewarding experience.

At the AGM, social distancing will remain in place but we will still be able to seat between seventy and eighty members with the Board members seated at a table on the stage so

please don't take the view you shouldn't attend the meeting. If necessary, courtesy of our new PA system, we can accommodate any overflow in the bar area.

On a more positive note, the Club has traded reasonably well during July and August despite the COVID restrictions and the bowler numbers have also been reasonably good, especially on Wednesdays with a number of ladies now participating which is great to see.

I thank everyone for cooperating when it comes to observing the COVID regulations regarding social distancing, completing the attendance forms, sanitising equipment and washing of hands etc. I think we all lapse at times but we must be vigilant - our lives depend on it.

## BOWLS CALENDAR 2020

An updated Bowls Calendar has been produced and sent to all on email recently. September-October details are included in this newsletter. Our website Calendar has also been updated to reflect the present position.

Competition results have been updated to reflect the results of recent finals.

## FRIDAY NIGHT RAFFLES

Since our restart, our Friday raffles have done very well, reflective of the numbers attending for dinner. We now have two x meat trays provided by A and M Meats, two x fruit trays provided by the Fruitologists Brisbane Markets and two x meal vouchers on offer. My thanks to the ticket sellers who attend on a rostered basis and particularly the new sellers, who commenced this month. More sellers are required, so please contact me and I will include you on the roster.

## GRANTS

### Gambling Community Benefit Fund (GCBF)

Following our unsuccessful attempt to obtain a grant to replace the lighting on both greens with LED, we then looked at simply replacing the bulbs on the top green which would improve the quality of light. We asked for a quote to perform this work and it came in at \$11,134.00 plus GST. Over \$4,000 of this is to gain access to the poles. It was also

suggested we look at a new Phillips product much less expensive than the other LED lighting and not much more expensive than relamping. Cost of this option is \$17,148.19 plus GST of which we have sought a grant from GCBF of \$14,500.00 plus GST which means our contribution is minimal. Benefit is not only better lighting but lower power costs being LED.

I am delighted to say the grant has been approved in full and funds have been received. A meeting with the contractor has put everything in place with lamps and other requirements ordered. Delivery time could be 12 weeks or more based on the contractor's recent experience. Work will be carried out on a Thursday with Friday to complete if required.

### Active Restart Infrastructure Recovery Fund

A grant of \$10,000.00 plus GST has been applied for to partly cover the cost of painting our Clubhouse roof. Grant is under the Active Restart Infrastructure Recovery Fund by Queensland Government Sport and Recreation Department. A large area of our roof is rusted and this will allow for cleaning down and removing all loose existing rust, treating with rust inhibitor to stabilise the surface, treating with a rust converter and painting with two coats of Dulux Acra-Tex roof membrane. This will not only preserve the

roof, but fill areas which may cause a leak. Total cost is \$11,200.00 plus GST. Decision date for this grant is 30th September 2020.

### Lord Mayor's COVID-19 Direct Assistance Program 2020-2021

A grant of \$10,000.00 plus GST has been applied for from the Lord Mayor's COVID-19 Direct Assistance Program 2020-2021. Funds are to assist us by reimbursing us for larger expenses during lockdown. Our largest expense over which we have no control is that

of insurance and this has been the expense for which the funds have been requested. There is no stated closing date as the grant will close once sufficient applications have been received to exhaust the allocation of funds.

## RETIREMENT & LIFESTYLE VILLAGE BOWLS DAYS

We had a day planned for August and issued an invitation to Villages to attend. Unfortunately people are not prepared to venture out yet, which is quite understandable under the circumstances. We had a few teams who were prepared to attend, however not sufficient to run the day. The event was cancelled and we will again investigate the situation in October.

## Covid-19 Hits Pensioners Again



Every fortnight when pensioners get their age pension or other Centrelink payments you just see one amount go into your nominated bank account but the payment is in fact a combination of 3 different payments.

1. Basic Pension - \$860.60 for a single and \$648.70 each for a couple.
2. Energy Supplement (this is a hangover from when the Federal Government was going to impose a carbon tax back in 2010. If it was imposed pensioners would have been forced to pay more for goods and services and the Government granted this supplement to compensate pensioners. When the Abbott Government came to power they shelved the carbon tax but never took away this supplement. The full benefit is about \$14.10 for a single and \$10.60 each for a couple.
3. Pension Supplement (there used to be a number of allowances available for pensioners but over time they were all bundled into this supplement which all pensioners get. The maximum pension supplement is \$69.60 for singles and \$52.50 each for a couple.

So on the 20<sup>th</sup> March and 20<sup>th</sup> September each year pensioners usually get a pay rise in line with a formula that is linked to inflation.

Centrelink pensions and allowances will not index on 20 September this year. This is the first time they have not indexed since 1997.

The basic rate of age pension is indexed by the greater of:

- Consumer Price Index (CPI) or
- Pensioner Beneficiary Cost of Living Index (PBCLI), and must remain at least 27.7% of average weekly earnings.

The pension supplement is increased by CPI and the energy supplement is not indexed.

During the June 2020 quarter, both the CPI and the PBCLI were negative. So while pensions and allowances won't be indexed, at least some consolation is that the government has confirmed the payments won't be decreased.

Another consolation is that pensioners (and others) have been paid two \$750 Economic Support Payments over the last 6 months as a recognition of the rising costs due to coronavirus.

Let's hope that things improve in the next 6 months and that when the next rise is due on 20<sup>th</sup> March things have improved to a level where pensioners get an increase.

One never know but maybe, just maybe there might be a sweetener or two in the Federal Budget that Josh Frydenberg will hand down in October.

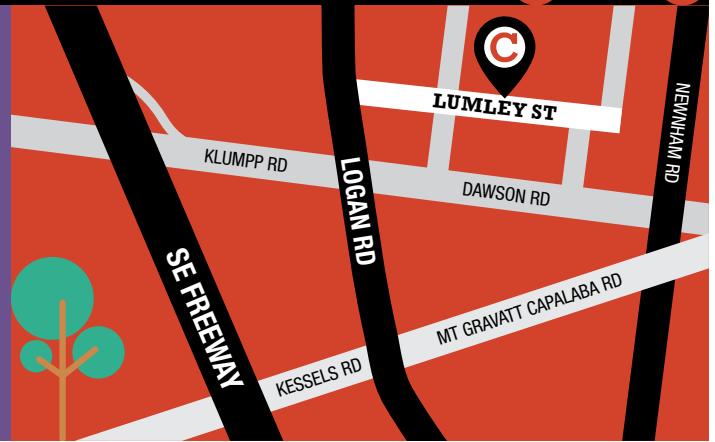
