# BUSINESS MANAGER'S REPORT

## Sponsors and Bowls Calendar 2021

We welcome one new sponsor this newsletter. Our member and former treasurer, Heather Upton operates a bookkeeping business known as Basics to BAS. Heather is now sponsoring the last Wednesday morning pairs each month. This provides the prize money with a boost on these days. Some of our sponsor's advertising signs have either been or soon will be updated as their details have changed. These include Zupps, Stellario Realty Group, Southside Toyota and a little while back, Tricare.

## Grants

We currently have a grant lodged with the Gambling Community Benefit Fund for \$20,000 to construct a new retaining wall on the Western side of the covered green. You will note a couple of bends in the present structure with posts giving way. Grant application was lodged midway through April with a decision expected in September.

Formal approach has been made to Brisbane City Council, our landlord, for approval to complete the work. This decision is expected soon.

We are always on the look out for a suitable grant to refurbish the bottom green. No grant availability of that size has occurred, however when it does we will follow it through.

## Retirement and Lifestyle Village Bowls Days

Village days are running well. We have a small decrease in numbers for May, mainly due to other competitions being on at similar times, however the roll up was still great and a very enjoyable day was had by all who attended.

## Solar Panels

Installation of the additional solar panels has been completed. We are not able to switch the new panels on at present until Energex has completed their final tests. We are hopeful they will be functioning by early June.

## Property News

We are in the process of obtaining quotes to replace the soffits along the front of our building. These have been water damaged over time and look unsightly. Prior to the replacement we have had our plumber look at fixing the leaks. Once this has been completed we will have the Logan Road end, frontage and rear area painted. A quote has been obtained for this work, however no point in completing the work until the panels have been replaced. We will also have the area under the eaves on the veranda painted where recent repairs have been made.
