## CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Dear Members,

Well, here we are, two months into 2022 and we are still dealing with COVID restrictions and the vaccination mandate. This situation continues to have a negative impact on the hospitality and club industry with revenues down on average around twenty percent across the board. The big poker machine clubs and the pubs have been the worst effected, and our revenue is also down but not necessarily to that extent. Clubs Queensland and the Queensland Hotels Association have formed a rare alliance and are lobbying the Government to lift the restrictions and the vaccination mandate now that more than ninety percent of the community is fully vaccinated. Hopefully, this will happen in the very near future.

Because we are still dealing with COVID restrictions I want to remind everyone you must wear a mask when you enter the Club premises and when you go to the bar to order drinks, food or pay green fees etc. Do not be offended or give staff a hard time if you are not wearing a mask and staff refuse to serve you or ask you to put a mask on because they are only doing their job, as instructed, and following regulations.

We are aware that several our members have contracted COVID in recent weeks, but all had been fully vaccinated and no one has required hospital treatment to the best of our knowledge which is fantastic.

As you will read in the Business Manager's Report, we missed out on the first round of the Brisbane City Council Grants program to

refurbish the bottom green, but we will be applying for the second round which opens later in March. However, work will commence shortly on the replacement of the bottom green retaining wall and fence. Reg will be providing full details in his report.

I think by now everyone will have noticed that the soffits along the southern side of the building have now been replaced and new LED lighting installed. During that process we found the box gutter above the soffits was badly corroded in places and we also needed to replace downpipes. The box gutter has been repaired but will need to be fully replaced within the next three to five years – at considerable expense. It would appear the box gutter was the cause of the damaged soffits.

I think, as everyone knows, things move very slowly in the Brisbane City Council. I have been advised the "temporary" safety plan for the exit thoroughfare through our car park has been done but it was sent back for further amendment by Community Leasing because it did not meet the requirements that were discussed at the meeting held on site between all parties involved, including the Club representatives.

We continue to have people from the school and the community hall using our car park because the belief is still out there that our car park is a public car park - as the Greens Director found out recently when questioning parents waiting to pick up children. The Board has obtained quotes for signage warning people it is not a public car park and that

their car may be towed if they continue to park there. However, Community Leasing has asked us not to erect the signage until all issues in relation to the changes have been implemented. Apart from employing security personnel or asking for volunteers to move these people on there is little we can do about it for the time being.

Our Dad's Army team of volunteers continue to do sterling work around the club. Unfortunately, their numbers are beginning to dwindle so if you can spare a few hours on Thursday morning you will be most welcome. On that note, I wish to specifically recognise three members – Brian Prescott (Mr Fix It), Eddie Munro and Ian Svensson. These three gentlemen do more than most in looking after the maintenance around the club and Brian, in particular, has saved us a lot of money over the years doing repairs that would have cost us a lot of money if a tradesman had been brought in. Don Hart is another one who has been a regular behind the bar helping Julie. He looks after the Monday night Greek Social Bowlers generating revenue that does not warrant employing staff.

Last, but certainly not least, Jeff McLennan – AKA "The Magpie". Jeff travels from home on the Gold Coast every weekend to work behind the bar and more often when Julie is on leave or she needs assistance. He is a mentor to Julie and has had a big influence in her development as a competent Club Manager.

We are looking forward to a big year this year

# BUSINESS MANAGER'S REPORT

## Sponsors

A huge thank you to all sponsors who have agreed to support us again this year. Your support is very much appreciated by all concerned.

Both the paper based Bowls Calendar and the Website Calendar have been completed for the year. Changes will be made as necessary. Version 2 of the paper based copy have been sent to all on email.

## Grants

Our grant application to Brisbane City Council for funds to replace the base, underlay and carpet on the bottom green has unfortunately been unsuccessful. Simply there was insufficient funds available to cover all requests. There is a round 2 of the grant program which closes at the end of March and we have been encouraged to resubmit in that round, which will occur. We must understand there is much competition for the grants and only high quality submissions covering in detail the information requested will be considered.

There is a second grant opportunity available under the Gambling Community Benefit Fund. This is titled a "Super Grant" and closes end of March. There is consideration being given to our kitchen being upgraded under this grant. The consideration is in the early stages so I am unable to provide further details at present.

## Retirement & Lifestyle Village Bowls Days

These days continue to operate smoothly on the second Friday of each month from February to November inclusive. Team numbers are down on what is ideal and we are trying to boost the numbers. We now have Council approval for both with the fencing contractor stating he can begin in early March. Once the fence is complete the retaining wall can proceed in line with availability of the contractor.

## New Satellite Hospital

I hope everyone has had a safe start to 2022! I am pleased to announce that the final location for the Palaszczuk Government's Satellite Hospitals program for South-East Queensland is in Eight Mile Plains on Levington Road (next to the RACQ Office).

This new Satellite Hospital is set to host a wide range of services, including community health services, ambulatory and low acuity day therapy services such as renal dialysis, chemotherapy, complex wound management, urgent care for minor injury and illness, and outpatient activities.

The Palaszczuk Government has committed \$265 million to building seven Satellite Hospitals in high growth areas across South-East Queensland. The Satellite Hospitals will deliver convenient and community focussed care closer to home, reducing pressure on our busy health system and will create around 773 jobs during construction. I know this infrastructure will be much welcomed by our community, I can't wait to see it open in 2023!

# GREEN DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Dad's army as we are affectingly called consist of only 10 people. Not everyone turns up on workdays and we have had days when only 4 are present. We work mainly Tuesdays and Thursdays but come in other days when required. Lately Covid has reduced our numbers more. Whilst the greens are our priority, we also mow the lawns, tend to the gardens, clean the car park, clean the patio and surrounds, replace neon tubes and light bulbs and do some maintenance and painting inside and outside the club house.

Whilst most of our members are tidy and leave no mess/rubbish behind when they finish their game, we have some bowlers that fail to clean up their mess before, during and after their game. For years, we have removed plastic cups from chain wire fencing, on top of the rink dividers, under seats and left on the tables. Cigarette butts have been stubbed out on the concrete and left there or thrown into the gardens or lawns. Some of these butts end up on the greens. There are cigarette burns in the surface of the top green. Remains of chewing gum are found on the rink surrounds. We have collected lolly, gum and biscuit wrappers from the rink surrounds and in the ditches. Fruit remains were left in one of the gardens. We don't have a gardener and it would remain there for months before it broke down and returned to the soil.

Bowlers are not clearing and re-setting the scoreboards after their social games. Some members are using permanent marker to put their team names up resulting in it has to be repainted to remove it. The plastic stackable chairs are left where they were last used often blocking the space between the green and the permanent seats. The steps are occasionally left on the rinks. On the top green, shades and occasionally the flags are left out. Returning these items to their proper places would assist.

We don't have bins and ashtrays at each end of every rink but you don't have to walk far to find one.

Some may blame the barefoot bowlers causing the mess but there was no increase in the amount of litter over the November/December period.

It makes our job easier and gives us extra time to do other work when members clean up after themselves when they finish bowls.

This is your club so take some pride in it and clean up whilst you play and when you finish your games.

# PARLIAMENT PASSES LEGISLATION TO ENHANCE THE SUPERANNUATION SYSTEM

The Morrison Government has passed through the Parliament the *Treasury Laws Amendment (Enhancing Superannuation Outcomes For Australians and Helping Australian Businesses Invest) Bill 2021* which will ensure superannuation continues to work in the best financial interests of all Australians.

The passage of the Bill will provide more flexibility for families and individuals preparing for retirement by allowing individuals aged between 67 and 75 to make non-concessional superannuation contributions under the bring-forward rule. The legislation also supports the repeal of the work test for non-concessional and salary sacrificed contributions made by individuals aged between 67 and 75.

The Bill also delivers on a key commitment in the 2021-22 Women's Budget Statement by removing the \$450 per month income threshold under which employees do not have to be paid the superannuation guarantee by their employer. This will remove an outdated structural feature of the superannuation system and in doing so will improve equity in the system.

These superannuation measures will take effect from 1 July 2022.

The Bill will also reduce costs and simplify reporting for superannuation funds by allowing trustees to use their preferred method of calculating exempt current pension income where the fund is fully in the retirement phase for part of the income year but not for the entire income year. This measure will apply for the 2021-22 income year onwards.

The Bill and explanatory material are available on the Parliament of Australia website.

Through these measures, the Morrison Government is ensuring the superannuation system works harder for all Australians by strengthening protections around the retirement savings of millions of Australians.

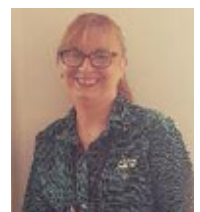
