



Beer Tasting Paddle
Black Hops – Ginger Cider – 4.8%
This apple-based cider with a hearty ginger addition is the Black Hops go-to for the non-beer drinker. This easy drinker is the perfect palate cleanser or summer time refresher.
Moffat Beach - Social Jam Mid - 3.5%
Lower in alcohol, but amped up with full-flavoured hoppy goodness, an enticing tropical aroma and balancing bitterness.
Sea Legs – Zamba IPL - 5.8%
Second hop off the rank, Zamba out of the US. While a not-so-mainstream hop, Zamba is a great all-rounder on the dry hop front. We've chosen to brew an India Pale Lager with a generous dry hop, accentuating a super clean stonefruit & tangerine hop character.
Last Man Standing – Mid 3.5%
Delivers big on refreshment – Crisp, mild bitterness and balanced with a subtle malt finish.
Easy Times Brewing Co - Underarm Sour - Mango Kiwifruit - 4.1%
All Inn Brewing – Japanese lager – 4.5%
Sushi rice and light honey aroma with a touch of grass. Flavour follows the aroma. Light and clean with moderate sweetness. Very easy drinking.
Black Hops – Foreverland 5.5%
Big pithy grapefruit and citrus dominates the aroma and flavour with a smooth, soft hazy malt bill to balance it out.
Black Flag brewing – Astro Punk XPA – 5.1%
Packed full of Eclipse hops for a big hitting, fruit forward flavoured taste bursting with sweet mandarin, zesty citrus and fresh pine
Your Mates – Donnie Dark Ale – 5%
Donnie is the strong, silent type. He might seem a bit intimidating at first, but once you crack a beer with him you'll find that he's a smooth operator with a heart of gold.
Ten Toes – Sugar Road Ginger Beer – 4%
Don't listen to the devil on your shoulder, embrace life with this uber fresh ginger refresher, party hard and embrace your Sugar road
Aether – Blackberry Sour – 3.9%
Brewed with Tasmanian blackberries, our classic Berliner Weisse-style Blackberry Sour pours a dramatic purple and is the perfect mash-up of sour and sweet.
Ballistic Beer – Mexican Hot Chocolate – 6.7%
This Milk Stout is brewed with cocoa nibs, lactose, chilli and spices. It's dark and dangerously drinkable. Perfectly balanced and unexpectedly moreish. Dark and chocolatey, with a subtle tickle by the chill at the back of the mouth
Slipstream Brewing – G-Force IPA - 6.5%
Brace yourself for a change of speed—G-Force doesn't follow the same well-worn roads as other IPAs. You'll taste familiar flavours, but also find yourself intrigued. You won't come up against an explosion of tropical fruits, and you won't find a dank, resinous West Coast IPA. We took inspiration from the juicy IPAs of Vermont but didn't want to be limited by their style.
Ten Toes Brewing – Pipeline Pale Ale – 4.7%
