EMBRACING TECHNOLOGY

While I have stepped down from the Board Chairman position it does not mean I have stepped away from using my skills to help the Club to continue to develop financially and secure its future.

I enjoy contributing as a Representative Selector, Club Coach and National Umpire and I also enjoy assisting our Club Manager, Julie, with the POS system and assisting when needed behind the bar. I have nearly forty years' experience in the Catering and Licensed Club Industry and those skills are much needed to run a successful Club.

Since taking back the lease of the property from Club Southside, we have embraced technology with the introduction of our own POS (Point of Sale) system and member rewards program and the introduction of Bowlslink. Our Club is a leader when it comes to Bowlslink with David Chattin now the District Coordinator. Both David and Bob Chattin go to other District Clubs to train them on how to use Bowlslink. Bob's background as a computer analyst with the State Government has been of enormous help here.

We have now taken another step forward in embracing technology with the Board approving the implementation of an online booking system for barefoot bowls. As far as we are aware, we will be the first Club in Brisbane to use this system. However, it is operating very successfully at the Coolangatta Bowls Club on the Gold Coast.

Our target market is the younger age groups who have embraced technology and if they can't do it on their smart phones then they don't do it. This booking system will allow customers to book their BFB sessions, order catering from a menu and pre-pay online in a matter of minutes. I think most of us have booked flights, holidays, sporting events, theatre tickets and even our groceries online so this will just fit in with all of that and provide a great service for our BFB customers.

This exciting new technology comes at minimal expense to the Club with a booking fee being paid by the customer, just as you do when booking those tickets online, covering the cost. The only cost to the Club will be the financial transaction fee which we pay now for all EFTPOS and Credit Card transactions.

Julie will be able to download a daily report which will list all the bookings and catering orders thus saving many hours each week on the phone.

David Chattin and I will assist Julie by looking after the "back of house" and any issues that may arise just as I currently do with the POS system.

While this new technology is fantastic, we still need people on the ground to look after the barefoot bowlers and to protect our greens so if you haven't already put your name down as a volunteer then please do so next time you are in the Club. This is a pleasant way to spend a couple of hours and you will be helping the Club to maximise the revenue without the Club having to pay additional wages. This revenue is critical to the Club's financial viability.

GRANTS OFFICER REPORT

Kitchen Floor Replacement

Thank you to the Lord Mayor's Better Suburbs Grant-Community Support Category for a grant of \$10,000 plus GST to assist in replacing the kitchen floor. As previously reported the floor had cracks across it which allowed moisture to penetrate it. We waited until early in the New Year to complete to ensure as less disruption to normal work occurred. Work commenced Monday 5 February and the kitchen was functioning again by late Thursday. Whilst work was being carried out we took the opportunity to have our gas equipment checked and was found to require some updating. Whilst requiring additional expense, it was necessary to ensure compliance with current legislation.

All work is now completed, the tax invoices have been paid and all that remains is to complete the acquittal which is under way.

Covered Green Roofing

As reported previously we have a grant lodged with The State Government Sport & Recreation Minor Infrastructure grants under the category "End of Life" component for funds to replace the current roofing strips with Wonderglass heavy duty glass with Suntuff capabilities. This material as the name suggests is not only tough, however it is very clear which will allow much more light through and lower our power bills as we will have less reliance on lights. Total cost with contingencies is a little under \$90,000 which means our 20% contribution will be \$18,000.

Decision expected March 2024, work to be carried out as soon as possible thereafter provided we are successful.

Under Covered Green Roof Cleaning

Hand in hand with the above grant is a grant to clean the underside of the covered green roof. As a result of the type of material that the roof is built from, the entire area will not stand pressure cleaning and will need to be hand washed. Total cost is \$12,060.22 incl GST, our contribution will be \$1,000.

Decision time late February, March 2024.

Retractable Shades Structure

During January the rope closest to the Clubhouse broke. The Shadex technician who originally installed the shades attended and took care of the replacement. Whilst here we took the opportunity to have him check the other ropes, pulleys and motors and he adjusted the "travellers" on each rope. He was asked what if anything we should be doing to protect the ropes from further such breaks. We were advised to apply silicone to the ropes on a regular basis which will enable movement to be much freer. He is making a piece of equipment for us which will enable the silicone to be applied much easier. Suggested we use food grade silicone which can be readily purchased.

Information has been shared with the Greens Director.

FINANCE WITH PETER DONOVAN THE RISK OF RISING RETIREE DEBT

Retiree debt needs to be acknowledged as an issue by industry, government, and regulators so that we can work together to provide Australians with greater financial confidence in their retirement.

Looking at recent research, conflicting trends regarding retirement confidence^[3] have emerged. A recent report from TAL and Investment Trends reported that Australians are more optimistic about how they will fund their retirement despite inflation and rising interest rates. Meanwhile, the 2023 MFS Global Defined Contribution Survey contrastingly found that inflation continues to erode retirement confidence, with over 60% saying they will need to work for longer and 40% no longer seeing themselves retiring at all.

While the loss of retirement confidence in Australia is in line with global peers, it also highlights the role that effective advice can play in helping investors meet their retirement objectives.

The earlier you can develop positive money habits and engage with a financial planner, the more confident you can be in retiring debt-free so you can enjoy life on your terms.
